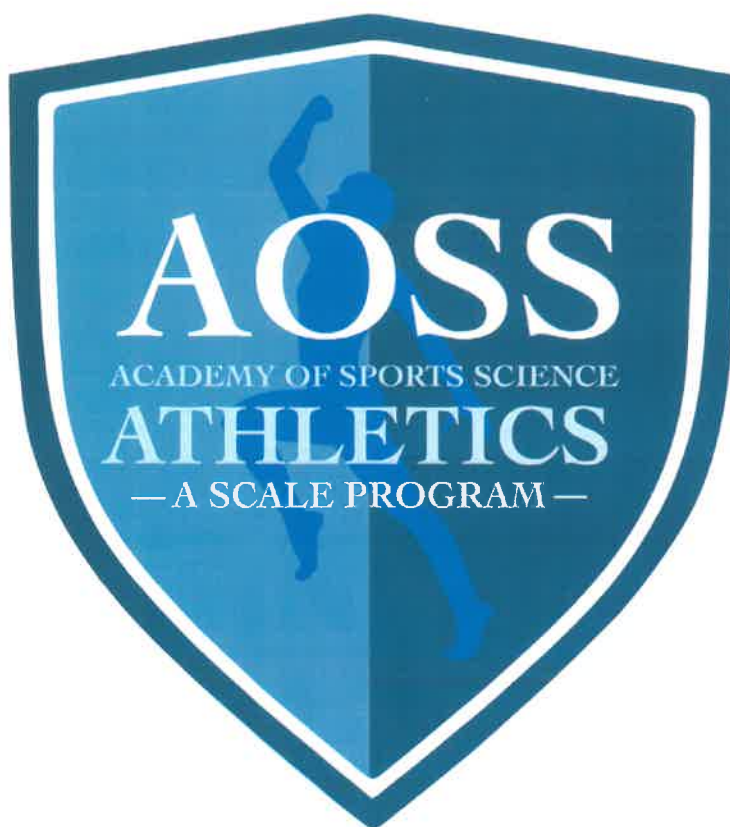

Student Checklist

New and Transfer Student Checklist & Guidelines

To submit a new application for I-20 the student must submit the following:

- Copy of passport
- Student's complete transcripts (translated into English with grading scale)
- **\$500 payment made via invoice link or check payable to "Academy of Sports Science"**
- Proof of financial responsibility (foreign bank certified letter)
- Foreign address and telephone number
- Local address and telephone number (where student will reside)
- Address of where the I-20 is to be mailed
- Custodial adult form signed

To submit a transfer application please submit all of the above along with:

- Copy of your current I-20 and I-901 receipt
- **\$200.00 payment made via invoice link or check payable to "Academy of Sports Science" instead of the aforementioned fee OR, \$425 money order if being mailed outside the U.S.**
- **Download the SEVIS transfer form below to return to your current school:**
 - AOSS (School Code is: **LOS214F55490000**)
- *Custodial Parent form is not needed if the student will be residing with a parent.*

- 1. Application for Form I-20**
 - All fields must be filled out. Incomplete application forms will be returned.
- 2. Copy of the student's passport**
 - Their passport should be valid for at least six months after the date they are scheduled to arrive in the United States.
- 3. Copy of the student's most recent transcripts**
- 4. Proof of financial responsibility**
 - Documentation should only be provided for the person who is paying the student's tuition.
 - Please provide a copy of the most recent bank statement or a bank certified letter stating the account balance. Do not submit tax documents.
- 5. Payment made via invoice link or check payable to Academy of Sports Science**
 - There is a **\$500 application** fee for new students and a **\$200 application** fee for transfer students.
 - We do not accept cash or personal checks.
- 6. Form I-20 Pick-up/Mailing Form**
 - Please see form below.

The experiences, knowledge, and differences represented by international students add diversity to the Academy of Sports Science High School campus. If you are considering Academy of Sports Science High School, review the admissions procedure below for international students. If you have questions, contact the Admissions Office.

International students must be issued an F-1 student visa before they arrive as a student in the United States. Academy of Sports Science High School is approved to issue an I-20. An I-20 allows international students to receive an F-1 visa to legally begin school in the United States. For more information, visit the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services website at www.uscis.gov.

Procedures for Obtaining an I-20

- Academy of Sports Science High School must have a complete application before issuing an I-20.
- Admissions international application fee of US \$500.00.
- Official acceptance from Academy of Sports Science High School.
- Academy of Sports Science High School tuition + technology fee must be PAID IN FULL [some additional fees may be required based on student program and billed separately at a later date].
- Submit a letter from your banking institution indicating you have sufficient funds to cover tuition for one year.
- Provide an American address where student will be living.

Once Academy of Sports Science High School has the necessary documents, we will issue the student an I-20 through the Student and Exchange Visitors Information System (SEVIS).

Procedures for Obtaining an F-1 Visa

- Read and understand your I-20 and your responsibilities as an international student in the United States.
- Once you receive the I-20, you will [go online to pay the SEVIS I-901](#) administrative fee, which must be paid three days prior to your embassy visit. The \$100 fee can be paid with a credit card. Your payment receipt should be presented at the embassy when you take your I-20 to apply for your student visa.
- Contact the United States Embassy or consulate and ask what documents are needed to obtain your student visa. You can visit the US Embassy website for your country to learn more about the documents needed.
- When the required documents are completed and fees are paid, you must make an appointment with the US Embassy. Getting an appointment with the US Embassy may take some time. Don't delay in making this appointment.

Once you Have Your F-1 Visa (Traveling to the U.S.)

- Keep your passport and I-20/F-1 visa with you at all times.



HOW TO APPLY



STEP 1: Gather Required Documents

- Student information (name, parent's name, address, etc.)
- Academic transcripts - 8th grade and/or equivalent translated into English
- Letters of recommendation: Principal, Math and English
- Copy of standardized test scores TOEFL, SLEP, or other English proficiency exams
- Copy of passport
- Any additional supporting documents



STEP 2: Apply

STEP 3: Interview

Once the initial application is received and reviewed by our Admissions Committee, a Skype interview will be scheduled in order to assess the student's English ability and learn about the student's academic record.



STEP 4: Acceptance & I-20

- After reviewing the student's application and results from the Skype interview, the student will be notified via email regarding their acceptance status.
- If the applicant is accepted, Academy Of Sports Science will process the I-20 application for an F-1 Student Visa.
- Once our school creates the I-20, it will be mailed to the student's family.
- Once the family receives the I-20 they are to then schedule an appointment with the Immigration Office at the United States Embassy nearest to them to obtain the F-1 Student Visa.

PARENTS' GUIDE TO IMMUNIZATIONS REQUIRED FOR SCHOOL ENTRY



Entry Requirements by Age and Grade:

Vaccine	4-6 Years Old Elementary School at Transitional-Kindergarten/ Kindergarten and Above	7-17 Years Old Elementary or Secondary School	7th Grade*
Polio (OPV or IPV)	4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)	4 doses (3 doses OK if one was given on or after 2nd birthday)	
Diphtheria, Tetanus, and Pertussis (DTaP, DTP, DT, or Tdap)	5 doses of DTaP, DTP, or DT (4 doses OK if one was given on or after 4th birthday)	4 doses of DTaP, DTP, DT, Tdap, or Td (3 doses OK if last dose was given on or after 2nd birthday. At least one dose must be Tdap or DTaP/ DTP given on or after 7th birthday for all 7th-12th graders.)	1 dose of Tdap (Or DTP/DTaP given on or after the 7th birthday.)
Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR or MMR-V)	2 doses (Both doses given on or after 1st birthday. Only one dose of mumps and rubella vaccines are required if given separately.)	1 dose (Dose given on or after 1st birthday. Mumps vaccine is not required if given separately.)	2 doses of MMR or any measles-containing vaccine (Both doses given on or after 1st birthday.)
Hepatitis B (Hep B or HBV)	3 doses		
Varicella (chickenpox, VAR, MMR-V or VZV)	1 dose	1 dose for ages 7-12 years. 2 doses for ages 13-17 years.	

*New admissions to 7th grade should also meet the requirements for ages 7-17 years.

WHY YOUR CHILD NEEDS SHOTS:

The California School Immunization Law requires that children be up to date on their immunizations (shots) to attend school. Diseases like measles spread quickly, so children need to be protected before they enter. California schools are required to check immunization records for all new student admissions at Kindergarten or Transitional Kindergarten **through** 12th grade and all students advancing to 7th grade before entry.

THE LAW:

Health and Safety Code, Division 105, Part 2, Chapter 1, Sections 120325-120380; California Code of Regulations, Title 17, Division 1, Chapter 4, Subchapter 8, Sections 6000-6075

WHAT YOU WILL NEED FOR ADMISSION:

To attend school, your child's Immunization Record must show the date for each required shot above. If you do not have an Immunization Record, or your child has not received all required shots, call your doctor now for an appointment.

If a licensed physician determines a vaccine should not be given to your child because of medical reasons, submit a written statement from the physician for a **medical exemption** for the missing shot(s), including the duration of the medical exemption.

A personal beliefs exemption is no longer an option for entry into school; however, a valid personal beliefs exemption filed with a school before January 1, 2016 is valid until entry into the next grade span (7th through 12th grade). Valid personal beliefs exemptions may be transferred between schools in California. For complete details, visit ShotsforSchool.org.

You must also submit an immunization record for all required shots not exempted.

為什麼你的孩子需要注射疫苗？

加州學校免疫法要求，兒童入園時必須接受最新的疫苗接種（注射）。

麻疹等傳染病傳播較快，因此入園前需對兒童進行保護。加州學校要求，所有入幼稚園或過渡幼稚園直至12年級以及入園前所有達到7年級的新生必須接受免疫接種檢查。

法律：

健康和安規法，105區，第2部分，第1章，第120325-120380節；加州法典，標題17，1區，第4章，第8子章，第6000-6075節

如果參加，需要準備哪些東西：

入園時，您孩子的免疫接種記錄必須顯示所有必需接種的日期。如果您沒有免疫記錄證，或您的孩子未按要求接受所有的疫苗注射，請立即聯繫醫師預約接種。

如果有執照的醫師出於健康原因決定不給您的孩子接種疫苗，可由醫師提交一份書面申請，可醫學豁免該次免疫接種，包括醫學豁免的持續時間。

個人信念豁免不再是入園的選擇；然而，2016年1月1日之前入園的有效個人信念豁免的有效期直至下一個年級跨度（7至12年級）。有效個人信念豁免可在加利福尼亞各學校之間轉換。詳細資訊，請訪問ShotsforSchool.org。

你還需要提交一份免疫接種記錄，確保所有必需疫苗已接種。
